On the 3rd of August the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of July 27th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioner, and Madison Stevens, Deputy County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from July 27th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Travis Benfield. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes; Chad Hulvey, yes, Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.
