

ORDER OF COUNTY COMMISSION

On the 11th day of May the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of May 4th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk and Madison Stevens, Deputy County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from May 4th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey yes, Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Stanley Long, Road and Bridge Assistant Supervisor, met with commission to discuss road and bridge maintenance. Bob Gowen off Hwy H received too much gravel. Commissioner Chad Hulvey asked for BCR 234 to receive more gravel, Bridge 356 needs work, BCR 368 needs more rock. Mark Welker asked commission to clean out ditches on BCR 900 because it has not been done. Presiding Commissioner asked BCR 872 ditches to be fixed.

Kevin Cooper, Emergency Management, met with commissioners to discuss FEMA projects and state that FEMA is going good.
