On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County:

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with the following officers and members, Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioner, Megan Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 2:12 p.m. which was deemed to be an Emergency Meeting.

Sheriff Stash Petton met with the commission to discuss the emergency situation with the courthouse. It has been noticed that the courthouse roof is getting worse and commissioners will need to make the decision on what to do with the jail. To move all the current inmates would cost around \$40,000 to house them elsewhere. It was discussed to proceed with tearing down the current courthouse to stop the immediate danger.

Cindy Buchheit with Unique Ambiance met with the commission to go over the current design/layout of the new County Admin building.

Ordered by the Commission that it do now adjourn until October 20th, 2025, at 8:00 A.M.
