On the 20th day of April the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of April 13th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey Associate Commissioner, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from April 20th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey yes, all were in favor, motion carried.

Ronda Elfrink, Assessor, talked to commission about joining the law suit with STC regarding them mandating counties to increase taxes by upward to 15%.

Nick Theile, Field Specialist, met with commissions to discuss concerns and updates regarding Extension Center

Brad Gregg, Road and Bridge Supervisor, met with commission to discuss road and bridge maintenance. Brad also mentioned the status of Bridge on County Road 456 needs to be replaced soon.
