On the 18th day of May the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of May 11th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.
