According to 2CFR(2CFR 200.305) the county must have all funds into a interest baring account but may only keep \$500.00 of interest and will be required to send all interest back to the ACH clearing house account. After discussion, the county decided it would be best for the county to open a new for SEMA/FEMA funds to be placed in to track all interest received.
