The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of August 3rd, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioner, and Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from August 3rd, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Travis Benfield. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes; Chad Hulvey, yes; Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, Road & Bridge Supervisor, met with commission to also discuss road maintenance and bridge maintenance. R&B has completed BCR 263, 628, 800. On the list to be completed is 352 brush, 710 brush, 418. BCR 423 is removed from the list due to conflict with landowners. The county will continue to grade and clean ditched.

Chad spoke to a citizen regarding BCR 356.

Commissioners & R&B supervisor listened to voicemails:

- BCR 346 when the road was graded, rock was pushed into the driveway, and the individuals could not get out.
- Zack, from SEMO university called regarding a survey they would like to conduct for non-profits
- BCR 852

Stanley Long and Eric McCall briefly observed the meeting waiting on the Treasurer to finish the check to purchase one new (too county) dumptruck for Road & Bridge.

Nonie Cowell, Collector had the commissioner sign the annual settlements from 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025.

Nick Theile, Missouri Extension, met with the commissioners regarding grants available.

Daniel Winningham observed the meeting briefly.

The commissioners also spoke about the transamerica corridor, Bollinger County is currently the only county in Missouri that is not supporting the cause.

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Megan Hill, County Clerk, spoke to the commissioners about the Marble Hill city hall meeting August 17th regarding vacate of a city street in between Archive center and Courthouse.

Captain Jackie Wilson met with the commissioners regarding the sheriff office about the Eagleview for the fly over for the 911 views, 6 inch would be \$26,000 for 3 years. The jail is currently full, the sheriff office is shipping out 4 females and 4 males charging 45 dollars per day per inmate at roughly a 3 month would be 32,400 that would cost the county.

Commissioner discuss renting the building currently owned by Everatt and Christy Reed. The building is available and ready for the Prosecuting Attorney to work out off. After some discussion, the commissioners agreed that this is the best spot for the new Prosecuting Attorney that will be taking office the beginning of January 2027. Chad Hulvey made the motion to approve the rental agreement and to continue to move forward with the building. Leo Arnzen seconded the motion. The vote is as follows: Leo Arnzen, yea; Chad Hulvey, yea; Travis Benfield, yea. All were in favor, motioned carried.

Travis Benfield left the meeting at 11:04 am to meet with Jeremy Manning and Brad Gregg, R&B supervisor, regarding bridges within the county.

The County Clerk and Commissioners discussed the future plans for the New Jail building and where the county office would be located. No decision was made, only discussion.

Commissioner Meeting was adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
