On the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey yes, Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, Road and Bridge Supervisor, met with commission to discuss road and bridge maintenance. BCR 456 is finished and the road is back open. Signs need to be ordered to be placed. BCR 416 needs rock placed. BCR 810 needs to be check from Spectrum work. The county is purchasing dirt from Kranwetter, roughly \$6,000 worth, to use for road build up.

- Rick called the county to discuss getting rip rap for his county road. They will pay for it if the county will spread it.

Travis Benfield, 2<sup>nd</sup> commissioner asked Brad Gregg to get creek permits for Perkins creek. All permits need to be renewed by August.

BCR 418 needs lots of rock dumped and spread. Also needs a pipe added as well.

Ordered by the Commission that it do now adjourn until June 1st, 2026, at 8:00 a.m
