

**ORDER OF COUNTY COMMISSION

On the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County:

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with the following officers and members, Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Kevin Cooper, Emergency Management, Megan Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 11:57 a.m.

Emergency meeting was called to order. At 10:18 am, Commissioner Chad Hulvey received a call from Sheriff Stash Petton reporting that the current roof to the courthouse looked as if it has gotten a lot worse since last time it was inspected. Chad Hulvey then came to the courthouse to inspect the roof and noticed the difference and how much worse things had gotten since last time the roof had been inspected. At that point, he alert the other commissioners to the issue at hand. Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner came to the courthouse and called an Emergency Meeting at this point.

It was discussed in the meeting about what we are currently going to due with a courthouse that is unsafe to employees and public. The "new" court admin and county admin building are currently in the process of plans drawn for bidding. We discuss state statues that may be out there for emergency situations about passing the bid statute to get the building ready for employees and everyone to a safe building sooner, rather than later. The commissioners adjoined the meeting to work on getting things more prepared in each building and to find out information regarding a emergency situation what statutes apply and whether or not we can hire several people to get these buildings ready for all employees and public.
