On the 20th day of July the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of July 13th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioner, and Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from July 13th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Travis Benfield. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes; Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Ameren filed to appeal with the BOE at 9:00 a.m. on July 20th, 2026. Ameren has protested 2013 2025 assessment and are now protesting 2026 assessment. Ameren is protesting the gas distribution system. Ameren was not present nor did they call by phone. Dotta Roberts and Ronda Elfrink had decision about Ameren and explained about current lawsuit Bollinger County and Ameren are in. After much discussion of the assessment Dotta Roberts made a motion to leave the valuation as set by Assessor, second by Leo Arnzen, vote taken results as follows: Travis Benfield, Yes; Leo Arnzen yes; Arnold Jansen, Yes; Dotta Roberts, Yes; All were in favor motion carried. County Clerk will send a decision letter to Ameren.
