

ORDER OF COUNTY COMMISSION

On the 8th day of June the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of June 1st, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from June 1st, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey yes, Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, R&B supervisor, Stanley Long, Assistant R&B supervisor, Bradley Baker met with the commissioners to discuss Road and Bridge maintenance. Commissioner Chad Hulvey stated BCR 878 needs to be fixed and pipes added in, BCR 208 needs to be built up, BCR 872 needs a pipe placed. Commissioner Travis Benfield stated BCR 652 and BCR 654 graded needs to be finished. BCR 718 BCR 719 BCR 716 needs to be bushed hogged. County Clerk mentioned BCR 320 for Ronda Brown and BCR 322 that it needs gravel and be graded.

Voicemails were listened to:

-Ronda Brown called the commissioner (and stopped by the clerk's office) to discuss BCR 320 that has damaged the driveway to Milton Mehas house. Leo Arnzen took down the phone number to call them back.

-Sharon Wilkinson-Crader called about BCR 338 but County did get to it during the week.

BCR 506 bridge is getting done today or tomorrow.

Sheriff Stash Petton and Captain Jackie Wilson met with commissioners to discuss updates with Sheriff office/Jail. The new SRO explorer came in for use. Sheriff Stash Petton asked the commissioners about what the update is on the current courthouse. The deadline with the safety of the jail is quickly approaching and Sheriff Stash Petton needs to know what to prepare for. The commissioners were asking about placing it on the ballot, but time has passed. Now it has been too late for ballot. The commissioners will speak to the county lawyer to see what can and cannot be done.

Kevin Cooper, Emergency Management, met with commissioners to discuss the FEMA updates and updates within the county. Kevin Cooper updated the commissioners about the sales tax increase that would happen if the income tax amendment was passed.

Coroner Calvin Troxell met with the commissioners to discuss getting an inverter for the coroner vehicle. Is asking the commissioners about getting a secondary cooler for the coroner office.
