The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey yes, Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, Road and Bridge Supervisor, met with commission to discuss road and bridge maintenance.

Base Rock Mineral is enforcing a possible 5%-8% increase.

Daniel Wingham with the Banner Press observed the meeting briefly.

Coop called to let us know that they can not get a 1,000 gal fuel tank till about a month. Coop can get a 500 gal tank till the 1,000 comes in. Discuss measures with Sheriff Stash Petton and Commissioners, agreed to wait for the 1,000.

Keith Simpson, Keith Simpson Contracting LLC, met with commission to discuss bridge work BCR 524 bridge, contracted was signed for \$458,813.00 on FEMA project.

Kevin Cooper, Emergency Management, met with commissioner to discuss updates within the county.

Sheriff Stash Petton and Captain Jackie Wilson met with the commission to discuss internet services. Semo Fiber will come out within 30 days to fix it. SRO vehicle needs to be replaced and no longer runs. Commissioners approve a new purchase of vehicle.
