On the 22nd day of June the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of June 15th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Travis Benfield and Chad Hulvey, Associate Commissioners, Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from June 15th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes, Chad Hulvey, yes; Travis Benfield, yes; all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, R&B supervisor, to discuss road maintenance and bridge maintenance. Presiding Commissioner mentioned BCR 406, 503, 426, 402 are roads citizens are currently concerned with. R&B has completed BCR 322, 878 and BCR 418 got patched waiting for grading. BCR 628 and 708 will be worked on during the week.

- BCR 808 called to inform commissioners that every time the grader comes through, they cut the ditch within the driveway.
- BCR 505 a tree fell within the road. R&B has already taken care of the fallen tree.

John McCarty with Arch Brokage met with commissioners to give insurance update with the county.

Billy Castile, Castile Construction, met with commissioners to discuss the process of tearing down the courthouse and wants to be part of the bidding process for removal of courthouse and asbestos removal.

Daniel Winningham observed the meeting briefly.

Keith Simpson met with the commissioners regarding BCR 416 bridge with project and commission informed him of Leopold picnic in July to let him know of inflex traffic.

Sheriff Stash Petton met with commissioners to give update regarding jail/sheriff office.

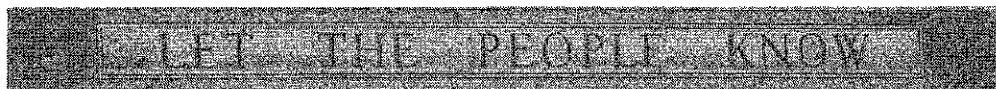
Leo Arnzen received a phone call from a citizen regarding BCR 500.
