On the 31st of August the following, among other proceedings, were had by the County Commission of Bollinger County.

The Bollinger County Commission met today pursuant to adjournment of August 24th, 2026 with the following officers and members: Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, Chad Hulvey and Travis Benfield Associate Commissioner, and Megan Jo Hill, County Clerk. Meeting called to order by Leo Arnzen, Presiding Commissioner, at 8:00 a.m.

Commission reviewed minutes from August 24th, 2026 commission meeting. Leo Arnzen made a motion to approve minutes as read, second by Chad Hulvey. A vote was taken results are as follows: Leo Arnzen yes; Chad Hulvey, yes, Travis Benfield, yes, all were in favor, motion carried.

Brad Gregg, R&B supervisor, met with commissioner to discuss Road & Bridge maintenance. They have completed BCR 628/624, BCR 404, and BCR 200 was mowed. To be completed this week is BCR 346, 356, 458.

Bo with McCoy met with the commissioners to discuss the purchase of a used grader they have for sale. Commissioners agreed to look at the budget then decide this week.

Rick Roark met with the commissioners to discuss his busted windshield which was caused by the R&B department. It was discussed that he would gather three quotes and then the commissioners will make an informed decision.

Ronda Elfrink, Assessor, spoke to the commissioners regarding the boundary issues with the Barks Residence. The Assessor has called DESE regarding the school districts line but DESE would not supply the Assessor stating that the Assessor sets the lines although the Assessor has never done this and could not find State Statutes. The schools have agreed to allow the kids to continue their education at Woodland. Zalma has agreed to this.
